So, the food market is back in full swing until end of October. From 11:00am*, the market will take place every Thursdays at the Habitations Jeanne-Mance (250 Maisonneuve East, near the community gardens) and every Fridays at the Émilie Gamelin park.

As last year, this economical, convivial and community market delivers fresh, healthy products to the residents and in the meantime, generates local jobs. Vegetables and fruits are available at low cost (on average 35% less than in supermarkets) and thanks to the cooperation of Bonne Boîte Bonne Bouffe, products mainly come from Quebec and the Montreal region in particular.
